Project Narrative: The Police Department Tactical Training Facility provides a space for the City's police officers to receive specialized, ongoing training for situational awareness and to further develop quality decision making while under stressful conditions. The training will comprehensively address officer response, from classroom lecture to simulated, multi-faceted scenarios encountered by officers. The approximately 9,000 square foot building will be located at the Northwest portion of the City's municipal complex and will repeat the architectural theme already established by City Hall. Included in the building are areas for training apparatus storage, driving simulation, live-fire exercises, and defensive less-lethal tactics. The Facility's aim is to increase the safety of both the public and our police officers and reduce liability in high risk/low frequency situations requiring split-second decisions, such as pursuit driving and responding to physical resistance. The groundbreaking was on February 18, 2016.
