Project Narrative: The Roadway Resurfacing Management Plan was adopted in 2001 by City Council. The plan evaluates roadway resurfacing for maximum surface life benefits for best costs. The plan takes a proactive approach to maintain the City's investment using scientific methods such as deflection testing and pavement distress that looks at road structure and degradation. This year the City has allocated \$400,000.00 to pave various roads throughout the City. Road prioritization is based on the recommendations provided by Infrastructure Management Services study.
