

Shady Lakes Drive Extension-Phase I

Project Narrative: The Palm Beach Gardens City Council adopted the Fiscal Year 2015-2016 budget, which includes the extension of Shady Lakes Drive north to 117th Court North. The extension provides connection of City Park and the City's Tennis Center to both roadways. The City is considering including pedestrian and bicycle access ways adjacent to the schools and parks, drainage, landscaping, irrigation, traffic calming, street lighting and other improvements typical of a City of Palm Beach Gardens community roadway.

Aside from the fiscal year budget appropriation of \$2.5 million set aside for the roadway, the project exists only in a conceptual phase. A survey and engineering firm has been hired to collect the data necessary for the conceptual design of the Shady Lakes Drive extension.
