PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the City Council of the City of Palm Beach Gardens, Florida, will conduct a Public Hearing on November 5, 2020, at 6:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as can be heard and continuing from time to time and place to place as necessary, in the Municipal Complex Building located at 10500 North Military Trail, Palm Beach Gardens, Florida, regarding:

RESOLUTION 64, 2020

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALM BEACH GARDENS, FLORIDA, APPROVING A SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM YEAR 2019 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN TO INCLUDE CARES ACT FUNDING (CDBG-CV) FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD); PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

As a grantee of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program, the City of Palm Beach Gardens has received Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus (CDBG-CV) funds authorized by the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) to be used to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus (COVID-19). In order to incorporate CDBG-CV funds into the most recent Annual Action Plan, a substantial amendment is required.

All members of the public are invited to attend and participate in this public hearing for the development of the substantial amendment to the Program Year 2019 Annual Action Plan. The amended Program Year 2019 Action Plan will detail the expenditures necessary to allocate the CDBG-CV funds. The project to be considered for final action by the City Council at the November 5, 2020, City Council meeting are as follows:

The amended fiscal year 2019 Annual Action Plan will be available for review from October 21, 2020, through November 4, 2020, at the Palm Beach Gardens Municipal Complex Building at 10500 North Military Trail, Palm Beach Gardens, Florida, and online at: <http://pbgfl.com/672/Community-Development-Block-Grant>

The City encourages participation of all its residents, especially the involvement of low- and moderate-income persons, minorities, non-English speaking persons, and persons with disabilities.

HUD recognizes the efforts to contain COVID-19 require limiting public gatherings, such as those often used to obtain citizen participation, and that there is a need to respond quickly to the growing spread and effects of COVID-19.
