## Special Needs Accommodations

We partner with The Arc of Palm Beach County to assess your needs.

## Resident (R) and Non-Resident (NR) Fees

Most Recreation Division programs offer a resident and a non-resident fee. City residents are offered the discount because their property taxes directly support our services. To be eligible for the resident fees, a participant must reside within incorporated Palm Beach Gardens and support city facilities and programs through property taxes. Some addresses will list Palm Beach Gardens as the city of residence but are not actually within incorporated Palm Beach Gardens. If you are not sure whether you are a city resident or not, check your property tax bill. If you are a resident, your property tax bill will include a line item specifically listing the City of Palm Beach Gardens. To qualify for the resident fee, each patron must provide verification of residency. Acceptable proof of residency includes a Florida driver's license with your current address or a Palm Beach County property tax document which lists a specific City of Palm Beach Gardens line item.
